


Parity Pricing Dose Optimization Saves Hospital \$5.85 PMPM

When drug manufacturers use parity pricing, it generates additional revenue for them at the expense of unsuspecting providers, plan sponsors, and their members. Providers may not know the medication they prescribed costs the same per unit regardless of the strength, causing the plan sponsor and member to unknowingly overpay for prescription drugs while adding no additional value for the member. Plan sponsors need an expert advocating on their behalf to provide independent clinical oversight and help remedy these unwarranted situations when they occur.



The Solution

Upon identifying the claim, the RxBenefits team of clinical pharmacists quickly intervened to optimize the dosing of this claim. We initiated a peer-to-peer review with a specialized physician. Our joint evaluation concluded that the daily 8mg dose could be optimized, safely switching the member from taking four 2mg tablets daily to taking one 3mg and one 5mg tablet daily. This switch would reduce the number of units daily by half, thereby cutting the cost in half as well.



Initial Regimen Afinitor Disperz Tablets Four 2mg tablets daily / 28 days

Pre-Rebate Monthly Plan Cost: \$62,225



Modified Regimen

Afinitor Disperz Tablets One 3mg and one 5mg tablet daily / 28 days

Pre-Rebate Monthly Plan Cost: \$30,215







Overall Optimization Results

RxBenefits worked with the prescriber to successfully redirect the high-cost prescription drug claim to a lower-cost option that meant fewer pills for the member to take each day. Our dose optimization intervention helped the health system reduce unnecessary spending for this claim, lowering its projected overall pharmacy benefit plan costs for the year.
